<u>Tuition Rates</u>			
Full Day	\$4,200	Half Day	\$2,200

Registration Fee - \$250 per family (Non-Refundable) Early Bird Discount of \$50 if paid by May 15, 2011.

Payment Options - All families must enroll in the FACTS Tuition Management Program unless Tuition, Registration and Technology fees are paid in full prior to August 15, 2011.

St. Andrew Country Day School Pre-Kindergarten program is a full cost recovery program.

- Families with children in Kindergarten – Grade 8 are not eligible for multi-child discounts for their child (children) enrolled in the Pre-Kindergarten program.
- Financial assistance is not available to children in the Pre-Kindergarten program. However, if your child is enrolled in Pre-Kindergarten 3 and then in Pre-Kindergarten 4 you will be eligible for a Tuition Rebate Program when you continue enrollment in grades Kindergarten, First and Second.
 - If your child has been in our Pre-Kindergarten 3 and Pre-Kindergarten 4 program, enrollment in our Kindergarten program will earn you a \$600 tuition credit on top of any other discounts that you may qualify for.
 - Enroll your child the following year in Grade 1 and you earn a \$400 credit. Continue into Grade 2 the following year and your credit will be \$200. That's a total of \$1200 in reduced tuition over three years.
- If your child enters St. Andrew Country Day School in Pre-Kindergarten 4 then the rebates will be pro-rated at 50%.

Facts Tuition Management - The FACTS Tuition Management Program is designed to allow families to have the option of a payment plan. Eleven (11) monthly payments will be made automatically from a checking or savings account or by credit card. These payments will begin in July 2011 and end in May 2012. There is an enrollment fee of \$38 as well as fees charged for insufficient funds. A convenience fee applies to credit card payments. You will have the option of making payments on the 5th, 12th, 20th, or 27th of the month. Each family is responsible to enroll in FACTS by May 15, 2011 or at time of enrollment for new families. If a family is in arrears after two months of failed electronic attempts by FACTS, an acceptable arrangement must be approved by the Business Office or enrollment in St. Andrew's Country Day School will be in jeopardy. The school has a right to legal action for non-payment of tuition and fees, and the parents will be responsible for the cost of collection.

Registration and Technology Fee - \$250 per family (Non-refundable) Due by May 15, 2011 (or at time of application if enrolling after May 15.)

Payment Options - All families must enroll in the FACTS Tuition Management Program unless Tuition, Registration and Technology fees are paid in full prior to August 15, 2011.

Early Bird Discount - \$100 - if Registration and Technology Fee and Tuition are paid prior to May 15, 2011.

Commitment 2011 - All families of students in Kindergarten through Grade 8 are obligated to contribute an additional \$300 through their participation in Commitment 2011. Families may select from the list of accompanying activities and fundraisers in any combination that totals \$300 or more. Any unsatisfied Commitment balance is due March 31, 2012 and will be added to your outstanding FACTS balance or by invoice if no tuition balance is due.

Parishioner Status - In order to qualify for parishioner status your family must be registered with the parish, children must participate in appropriate sacramental preparation programs, participate at weekly mass and utilize the church envelopes supplied to you. There is an expected family donation of \$10 per week in order to support the mission of St. Andrew's R. C. Church. This expectation is for all parishioners whether or not they have children attending St. Andrew's Country Day School. If you are an active parishioner at a parish without a school you may enroll in the Catholic Tuition Grant Program (CTGP) and be considered a Parishioner for purposes of tuition as long as you remain a member in good standing at your parish. CTGP forms are available in the school office.

Participating Status - As a Participating Parishioner or Participating Non-Parishioner you will be assigned to a Bingo Team and will be expected to work your assigned scheduled dates. Bingo is a major fundraising activity and is critical to the operation and upkeep of the school.

Facts Tuition Management - The FACTS Tuition Management Program is designed to allow families to have the option of a payment plan. Eleven (11) monthly payments will be made automatically from a checking or savings account or by credit card. These payments will begin in July 2011 and end in May 2012. There is an enrollment fee of \$38 as well as fees charged for insufficient funds. A convenience fee applies to credit card payments. You will have the option of making payments on the 5th, 12th, 20th, or 27th of the month. Each family is responsible to enroll in FACTS by May 15, 2011 or at time of enrollment for new families. If a family is in arrears after two months of failed electronic attempts by FACTS, an acceptable arrangement must be approved by the Business Office or enrollment in St. Andrew's Country Day School will be in jeopardy. The school has a right to legal action for non-payment of tuition and fees, and the parents will be responsible for the cost of collection.

Tuition Financial Assistance Guidelines

St. Andrew's R. C. Church has limited financial assistance available for those parish families that otherwise could not afford to have their children attend St. Andrew's Country Day School. We encourage families of the parish that might otherwise decide they cannot afford tuition to apply. This is funded by the Msgr. Graeber Scholarship Fund and the parish offertory (Commitment to Parish Life).

Families applying for parish financial assistance must meet the following criteria:

- ✓ Registered as parish members.
- ✓ Regular participation in the sacraments and Sunday Liturgy.
- ✓ Be participants in the "Commitment to Parish Life" offertory program.
- ✓ Apply for both CTAP, and Bison Fund prior to application.
- ✓ Supply prior year federal income tax return.
- ✓ Participate as a bingo volunteer.
- ✓ Participate in school fundraisers.
- ✓ Participate in FACTS Tuition Management Program and keep current with payments due.

Catholic Tuition Assistance Program (CTAP) and Bison Fund applications can be obtained online at buffalodiocese.org and the school office. Financial assistance awards are subject to adjustment once all aid has been determined e.g. CTAP and Bison Fund.

Those families eligible for the Catholic Tuition Grant Program (CTGP) will pay the same tuition as St. Andrew's families. CTGP applies if you're a member in good standing of a Catholic parish in the Diocese of Buffalo that does not have a parish school. If you are eligible for CTGP funding then any additional financial assistance would come from your home parish.

If you do not need financial assistance and want to help other families, donations to the Msgr. Graeber Scholarship Fund are always welcomed and needed.

Commitment 2011-2012

The Commitment program at St. Andrews Country Day School is a \$300.00 payment in addition to tuition. This program has been established to maintain level tuition while offering options to reduce this monetary obligation. The 2011 – 2012 Commitment Program will take a slightly new approach. You may select any of the options in any denomination to fulfill the \$300 Commitment.

Option 1

Payment in cash – includes total \$300.00 payment or the amount equal to \$300.00 after other commitment options have been fulfilled. April 1, 2012

Option 2

Fundraising - Easter Chocolate Sales include 50 percent of total sold April 1, 2012

Winter Cash Raffle (formerly Monte Carlo Raffle) includes dollar amount submitted February 4, 2012

Option 3

“SAS Improvement Days” – includes time and effort commitment of 4 hours to decrease payment by \$25. There is a maximum of 8 hours or \$50. Events include painting, cleaning, and other general school improvements. *You must be 18 years old or older to work these events.* Dates include: June, July, and August. Also, set up and clean up for Black and Gold Feb 3 and Feb 5.
